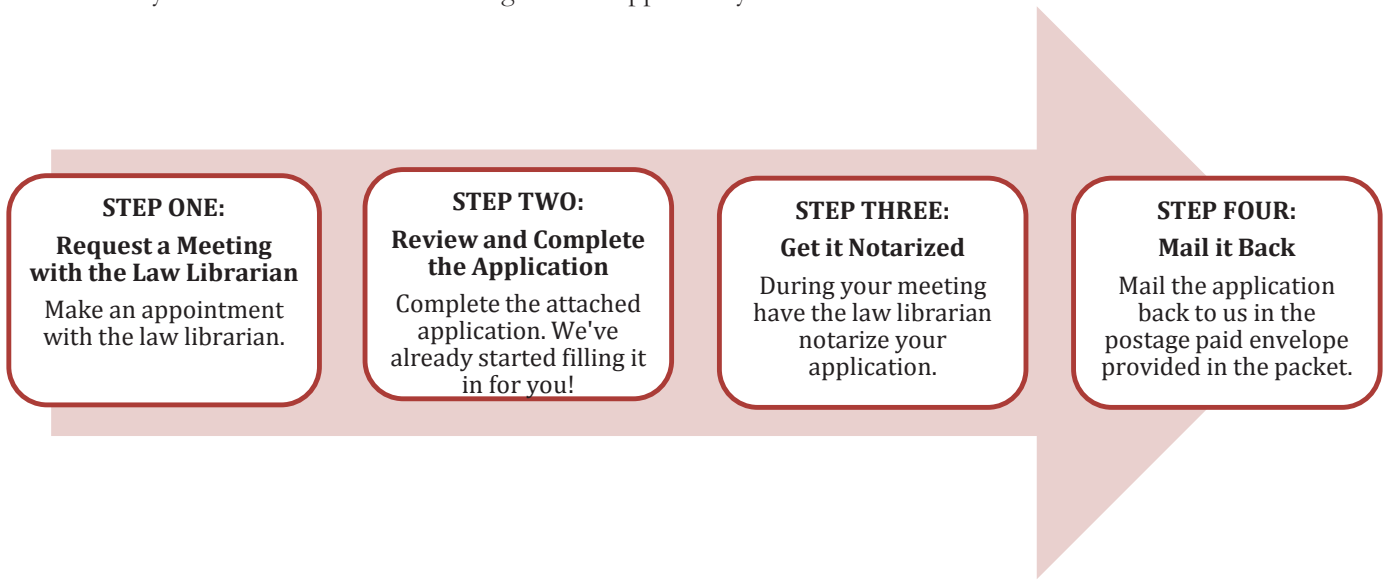
Dear Mr. John Doe,
